

Alexandria, Barcroft and Washington Transit Company, a respondent in the above captioned proceeding, has filed by its counsel a motion to extend until June 13, 1966, the time in which to institute the service required by Order No. 581, on the grounds that certain operational problems have arisen which will require additional time in which to institute the new services ordered, including the changeover in schedules for the summer period and the denial of the use of certain roadways for bus transportation.

The Commission is of the opinion that the public interest requires that the institution of this service be closely coordinated with existing service. A brief delay is warranted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the time specified in Order paragraph 3 of Order No. 581 as it applies to the Alexandria, Barcroft and Washington Transit Company be, and it is hereby, extended to June 13, 1966.
