A hearing was held on this matter on May 20, 1966, at 10:00 A. M., at the offices of the Commission. Notice to the public of date and time of the hearing was made by the Company as prescribed by the Commission's rules and regulations.


Mr. W. E. Bell, Assistant Vice President, D. C. Transit System, Inc., appeared as a witness for the Company. Briefly, the testimony of the Company was that the proposed extension was made pursuant to requests from the residents in the Fairfax Village area to provide a more convenient service. It was further stated that the service could be provided without additional manpower or equipment.

No protests to this extension were received and no one appeared at the hearing in opposition to the application.

The Commission is of the opinion that the public interest will be served by the extension of D. C. Transit's Route W-4 as proposed and, since no amendment to D. C. Transit's Certificate is required, the Commission will issue, herewith, the appropriate route authorization setting forth the proposed extension of Route W-4.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that D. C. Transit System, Inc., be, and it is hereby, authorized to extend Route W-4 as prescribed in Route Authorization No. 5 - 66 attached hereto.

Therefore, authority is hereby granted D. C. Transit System, Inc., to extend its Route W-4 to operate in the following manner:


PORTLAND STREET LINE, ROUTE W-4

Eastbound: No Change

Westbound:

- A. Discontinued Portion - From Pennsylvania Avenue and Fort Davis Street, south on Fort Davis Street and west on V Street to 38th Street.
- B. Extended Portion - From Pennsylvania Avenue and Fort Davis Street, continue southeast on Pennsylvania Avenue, southwest on Southern Avenue, west on Suitland Road and north on 38th Street to V Street, thence over regular route.
