

On October 17, 1966, D. C. Transit System, Inc., filed certain tariffs setting forth new increased fares, accompanied by the required application and supporting data. The tariffs have a proposed effective date of November 16, 1966.

The Commission is of the opinion that the tariffs should be suspended in order that the Commission may give consideration to the financial condition and revenue requirements of the Company, and to enable the Commission to determine whether it is being operated economically and efficiently and whether the proposed fares are just and reasonable.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that D. C. Transit System, Inc., Supplement No. 5 to Tariff No. 29, Supplement No. 3 to Tariff No. 28, and WMATC Tariff No. 3 (Joint) be, and they are hereby, suspended, and the use of the fares stated therein be, and they are hereby, deferred, pending investigation and hearing thereon, until February 13, 1967, unless otherwise ordered.
