On October 24, 1961, D. C. Transit System, Inc., filed an application to re-route the following bus lines in Washington:

1. Ager Road Express, Route F-9.
2. Anacostia-Congress Heights, Route A-1.
3. Benning, Route X-1.

The proposed changes are as follows:

a. A.M. - Eliminated portion - Routes A-1, and F-9 and X-1:
On 21st Street, N.W., between Constitution Avenue and C Street.

b. A.M. - Re-routed portion - Routes A-1, F-9 and X-1
Westbound: From the intersection of Constitution Avenue and 21st Street, N.W. - west on Constitution Avenue, north on 22nd Street, east on C Street and north on 21st Street to terminal stand at Virginia Avenue.


The requested re-routing of these three lines will not change the frequency or scheduled number of trips operated over these routes and will comply with the request of the U. S. Park Police.

The Commission is of the opinion that the proposed re-routing change will eliminate traffic congestion and the accident hazard at the 21st Street and Constitution Avenue, N.W., intersection.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

That the proposed changes contained heretofore in this Order become effective on November 6, 1961.
