By Application No. 480, filed March 18, 1968, WMA Transit Company requests amendment of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 8 to extend service to the Southwest Mall Area on all routes destined to Washington, as follows:

WESTBOUND

Pennsylvania Avenue Routes - Buses traveling Pennsylvania Avenue will follow regular route to 2nd Street, S. E. and Pennsylvania Avenue; continue on Independence Avenue; left on 3rd Street, S. W.; right on C Street, S. W.; right on 7th Street, S.W.; left on Independence Avenue.

South Capitol Street Routes - Buses traveling South Capitol Street follow regular route to Canal and C Street, S. W.; left on C Street, S. W.; right on 7th Street, S. W.; left on Independence Avenue.

New York Avenue Routes - Buses traveling New York Avenue will follow regular route to M Street, N. W.; bear right on M Street, N. W.; left on 3rd Street, N. W.; continue on 3rd Street, S. W.; right on C Street, S. W.; right on 7th Street, S. W.; left on Independence Avenue.

East Capitol Street Routes - Buses traveling East Capitol Street follow regular route to 3rd Street, N. W.; left on 3rd Street, N. W.; continue on 3rd Street, S. W.; right on C Street, S. W.; right on 7th Street, S. W.; left on Independence Avenue.

All routes after leaving the Southwest Mall area will turn left on Independence Avenue. Schedules will then be alternated to follow the routings as outlined below to Farragut Square.

15th Street Routing - After making left on Independence Avenue; right on 14th Street to Madison; left on Madison Street to 15th Street; bear right on 15th Street to H Street, N. W.; left on H Street and return to regular routing to Farragut Square bus stand.

17th Street Routing - After making left on Independence Avenue; continue on Independence until cut-off to 17th Street; continue on 17th Street to I Street, N. W.; right on I Street to Connecticut Avenue; right on Connecticut Avenue to proposed bus stop between H and I Street, N. W. (across the street from present Farragut Square stop.)

[1] After making left on Independence Avenue; continue on Independence until cut-off to 17th Street; continue on 17th Street to H Street, N. W.; left on H Street (*establish new bus stop here).

EASTBOUND

17th Street Routing - Leave bus stop between H and I Streets, N. W.; continue on Connecticut Avenue to Pennsylvania Avenue; right on Pennsylvania Avenue; left on 17th Street to Independence Avenue; left on Independence Avenue and reverse westbound route from this point until you return to the regular route. Possible variations leaving Farragut Square bus stop via 17th Street routing;

[1] Leave bus stop on H Street to Pennsylvania Avenue; left on Pennsylvania Avenue to 17th Street; right on 17th Street. Reverse westbound route from this point until return to regular route.

15th Street Routing - Leave bus stop between H and I Street, N. W.; right on I Street, N. W.; right on 15th Street to Independence Avenue; left on Independence Avenue and follow reverse westbound route from this point until return to regular route.

The proposed routings are subject to change, if feasible, when additional streets are opened.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That this matter be, and it is hereby, scheduled for public hearing on Wednesday, April 17, 1968, at 10:00 A.M. in the Hearing Room of the Commission, 1815 North Fort Myer Drive, Arlington, Virginia.

2. That applicant publish notice of application and hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, once, at least twenty (20) days prior to said hearing.

3. That any interested person desiring to be heard on this matter shall so indicate to the Commission in writing with a copy to applicant's attorney of record, Stanley H. Kamerow, Esquire, 1025 Vermont Avenue, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20005, at least five (5) days prior to said hearing.
