By application accepted for filing April 17, 2006, Norvel F. Wood, Jr., a sole proprietor trading as DC Tours and Transportation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with minibuses. Applicant's proposed tariff contains hourly group charter rates with an additional mileage charge and flat rates for transportation to and from Ronald Reagan Washington National and Washington-Dulles International Airports.

Applicant's Exhibit A does not include the make, model, seating capacity, or number of vehicles it plans to operate, nor does it indicate whether those vehicles are currently in applicant's possession. Applicant will be directed to file an amended Exhibit A.

Because applicant's principal place of business is in the District of Columbia, applicant will be directed to file proof of trade name registration with the District of Columbia Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than May 12, 2006, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than May 26, 2006, an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than May 26, 2006, an amended Exhibit A, which includes a vehicle list containing the make, model, seating capacity, and number of vehicles applicant will use initially plus copies of vehicle registrations for any vehicles already in applicant's possession.

4. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than May 26, 2006, proof of trade name registration with the District of Columbia Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs.

5. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing is May 26, 2006, and that copies must be served on applicant at 1001 Otis Street, N.E., Washington, DC 20017.
