Case No. MP-2006-174

Certificate No. 825 has been suspended since November 2, 2006, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 10,052, served November 2, 2006, noted that Certificate No. 825 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$50 late fee within thirty days.

Respondent has requested an extension of time to comply with Order No. 10,052, citing as grounds "financial and client problems for the last six months." Respondent has not indicated how much time it needs, and without some evidence that respondent's recovery is imminent, we find that respondent has not shown good cause for extending the compliance deadline.¹

Accordingly, Certificate No. 825 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact. The \$50 late fee shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 825 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 825 to the Commission.
