
Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 119 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$10 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on August 1, 2007, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 119 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02, and a \$50 late filing fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 10,662, served August 1, 2007.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$10 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on August 2, 2007 and tendered a \$50 check on August 21, 2007. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
