Certificate No. 1198 has been suspended since March 5, 2008, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 11,193, served March 5, 2008, noted that Certificate No. 1198 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$50 late fee within thirty days. Respondent has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the late fee. Accordingly, Certificate No. 1198 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

The \$50 late fee shall remain due. In addition, in accordance with Commission Regulation Nos. 60 and 67, respondent's unpaid \$150 annual fee for 2008, unfiled 2008 annual report, and another \$200 in late fees, shall also remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1198 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
  - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
  - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
  - c. surrender Certificate No. 1198 to the Commission.
