Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 372 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated without replacement at 12:01 a.m. on December 4, 2008. As a result, Certificate No. 372 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$50 late fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 11,732, served December 4, 2008.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement later that day and tendered \$50 cash on December 11, 2008. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
