Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1006 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1 million primary and \$500,000 excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent terminated on December 22, 2008, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 1006 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$50 late filing fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 11,766, served December 22, 2008.

Respondent filed acceptable \$1 million primary and \$500,000 excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on February 10, 2009 and tendered \$50 cash on February 2, 2009. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
