By letter dated January 5, 2009, applicant was directed to publish notice of this application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District no later than January 19, 2009, and file an affidavit of publication and a list of applicant's officers, directors, and shareholders no later than February 2, 2009. Applicant timely published notice and submitted an affidavit of publication, but has yet to file a list of applicant's officers, directors, and shareholders.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.<sup>1</sup> An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair examination of the application.<sup>2</sup> Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.<sup>3</sup>

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of B & T, Inc., for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
