Certificate No. 1799 has been suspended since December 13, 2011, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 13,078, served December 13, 2011, noted that Certificate No. 1799 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$50 late fee within thirty days. Respondent has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the late fee. Accordingly, Certificate No. 1799 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

In accordance with Commission Regulation Nos. 60 and 67, the \$50 late insurance fee and respondent's unpaid \$150 annual fee for 2011 and unfiled annual report for 2011 shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1799 is hereby revoked.
2. That respondent's 2011 annual report and \$200 in fees shall remain due in accordance with Regulation Nos. 60 and 67.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
  - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
  - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
  - c. surrender Certificate No. 1799 to the Commission.
