By letter dated April 18, 2013, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish additional information no later than May 2, 2013. The letter cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application.

Among other things, the letter requested the following additional information:

- Applicant's mailing address is also the address of Mohamed Salem Ould-Hemine, WMATC Carrier No. 2097. File a with the Commission a signed statement explaining your relationship with Mohamed Salem Ould-Hemine.
- File a copy of a lease or utility bill evidencing your presence at the Richmond, VA, location listed in the application as your principal place of business.

Applicant has yet to file a statement explaining his relationship with Mohamed Salem Ould-Hemine, and the "evidence" of applicant's presence at the Richmond, VA, location listed in the application as applicant's principal place of business consists of a third-party statement that is not sworn as required by Commission Rule No. 4-06.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair examination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

Inasmuch as applicant's response fails to fully satisfy the additional information request, this application shall be dismissed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Hemine Ould Abdallahi for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
