Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1776 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum. Under Regulation No. 67-03(c), \$100 is due and payable upon the failure of a carrier to timely file an acceptable WMATC Insurance Endorsement.

The \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent expired on August 7, 2013. A \$1 million primary endorsement was filed on August 6, 2013, however, the \$4 million excess has yet to be filed. Certificate No. 1776, therefore, is automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12 and may be revoked if respondent fails to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) and pay the \$100 late fee within 30 days.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. That respondent shall not transport passengers for hire under Certificate No. 1776, unless and until otherwise ordered by the Commission.
- 2. That Certificate No. 1776 shall be subject to revocation pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact, if respondent fails to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) and pay \$100 by money order, check, or online by credit card, within thirty days.
