Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 444 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1 million primary and \$5 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent expired on October 1, 2014. In their place, respondent filed a new \$1 million primary endorsement and a new \$3 million excess endorsement, leaving respondent \$1 million shy of the \$5 million minimum coverage requirement under Regulation No. 58. As a result, Certificate No. 444 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 15,096, served October 1, 2014.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$4 million, excess of \$1 million, WMATC Insurance Endorsement on October 2, 2014, and tendered a \$100 check on October 6, 2014. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
