The Commission issued Order No. 16,182, in this proceeding on February 4, 2016. The order revoked Certificate No. 1993 pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 58-15(a) for respondent's willful failure to maintain compliance with the Commission's insurance regulation, Regulation No. 58, and willful failure to pay a \$100 late insurance fee. The order noted in ordering paragraph No. 2 that the \$100 late insurance fee would remain due in accordance with Regulation No. 67.

It has been the practice of the Commission for many years to note in revocation orders whether, at the time of revocation, the subject carrier stood in arrears with respect to the carrier's obligation to pay an annual fee and file an annual report on or before January 31.¹ Inasmuch as respondent held Certificate No. 1993 on January 1, 2016, respondent was obligated to pay an annual fee and file an annual report for 2016 on or before January 31, 2016.² Order No. 16,182 failed to note that as of February 4, 2016, respondent had yet to pay the \$175 annual fee for 2016 and owed a \$150 late fee under Regulation No. 67-03(b) as a result. Order No. 16,182 shall be corrected consistent with the Commission's practice of noting a carrier's annual fee/report delinquency in revocation orders.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: That ordering paragraph No. 2 of Order No. 16,182 is hereby corrected to state as follows:

2. That respondent's \$425 in outstanding fees shall remain due in accordance with Regulation No. 67.
