This matter is before the Commission on the request of respondent for an extension of time to comply with Order No. 16,724, served December 7, 2016, which assessed a civil forfeiture of \$1,000 against respondent for transporting passengers for hire between points in the Metropolitan District on three days while Certificate No. 644 was suspended and for failing to timely produce documents as directed by Order No. 16,193.

Respondent tendered a \$100 check on December 16, 2016, and has requested an extension of time to pay the remainder of the forfeiture in equal monthly installments of \$100 that would be due on the 15th of each month beginning February 15, 2017. The request cites respondent's inability to pay the full forfeiture at this time.

Considering that under the circumstances respondent has made a good faith effort to comply with Order No. 16,724, and considering that respondent is otherwise in good standing, the requested extension shall be granted as follows: Respondent shall pay the remaining \$900 in nine monthly installments of \$100 each.<sup>1</sup> Each installment shall be due on the 15th day of the month beginning January 15, 2017.

Certificate No. 644 shall be subject to revocation upon respondent's failure to timely remit each installment payment.
