This matter is before the Commission on the reissuance of Certificate No. 539 in accordance with Order No. 16,725, served December 7, 2016, in WMATC Case No. AP-16-158.

Respondent is A-Fair Transportation Inc., a Maryland corporation formed on January 30, 2003, (A-Fair I). In Order No. 16,538, served in this proceeding on August 29, 2016, the Commission took official notice that respondent's corporate existence had been terminated pursuant to the laws of Maryland and directed respondent to file a certificate of good standing within 30 days or show cause why the Commission should not, among other things, suspend or revoke respondent's WMATC authority.

Instead of A-Fair I filing a certificate of good standing, a similarly-named affiliate - A-Fair Transportation Inc., a Maryland corporation formed on March 3, 2010, (A-Fair II) - filed an application on September 19, 2016, to acquire WMATC Certificate No. 539 from (A-Fair I).

On the strength of that application, the Commission declined to revoke Certificate No. 539. Instead, the Commission suspended Certificate No. 539 in Order No. 16,697, issued in this proceeding on November 22, 2016, and stipulated that the suspension would remain in effect until Certificate No. 539 was reissued to A-Fair II, revoked pursuant to Regulation No. 65, or otherwise terminated, whichever occurred first.

Inasmuch as Certificate No. 539 has been reissued this day to A-Fair II in accordance with Order No. 16,725 and no longer stands suspended, as provided in Order No. 16,697, this proceeding is hereby terminated.
