This matter is before the Commission on the reissuance of Certificate No. 1299 in accordance with Order No. 16,747, served December 15, 2016, in WMATC Case No. AP-2016-156.

Respondent is Miles Away Charter, LLC, a Maryland entity formed on September 9, 2004, (Miles Away MD). In Order No. 16,538, served in this proceeding on August 29, 2016, the Commission took official notice that respondent's legal capacity to transact business had been terminated pursuant to the laws of Maryland and directed respondent to file a certificate of good standing within 30 days or show cause why the Commission should not, among other things, suspend or revoke respondent's WMATC authority.

Instead of Miles Away MD filing a certificate of good standing, an identically-named affiliate - Miles Away Charter, LLC, a District of Columbia entity formed on May 21, 2015, (Miles Away DC), filed an application on September 19, 2016, to acquire WMATC Certificate No. 1299 from Miles Away MD.

On the strength of that application, the Commission declined to revoke Certificate No. 1299. Instead, the Commission suspended Certificate No. 1299 in Order No. 16,697, issued in this proceeding on November 22, 2016, and stipulated that the suspension would remain in effect until Certificate No. 1299 was reissued to Miles Away DC, revoked pursuant to Regulation No. 65, or otherwise terminated, whichever occurred first.

Inasmuch as Certificate No. 1299 has been reissued to Miles Away DC in accordance with Order No. 16,747 and no longer stands suspended, as provided in Order No. 16,697, this proceeding is hereby terminated.
