Certificate No. 2378 has been suspended under Regulation No. 58-12 since February 6, 2017, for respondent's willful failure to maintain compliance with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 16,834, served February 6, 2017, noted that Certificate No. 2378 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within 30 days. Respondent has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the late fee. Accordingly, Certificate No. 2378 shall be revoked pursuant to Regulation No. 58-15(a).

In accordance with Commission Regulation Nos. 60 and 67, the \$100 late insurance fee, plus respondent's unpaid \$175 annual fee for 2017, unfiled annual report for 2017, and \$300 in associated late fees, shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 2378 is hereby revoked.
2. That respondent's 2017 annual report and \$575 in unpaid fees shall remain due in accordance with Regulation Nos. 60 and 67.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
  - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
  - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
  - c. surrender Certificate No. 2378 to the Commission.
