By email dated March 15, 2017, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish additional information no later than March 29, 2017, including a list of applicant's members (owners). The email cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application. Applicant has yet to furnish a list of owners.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.<sup>1</sup> An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair determination of the application.<sup>2</sup> Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.<sup>3</sup>

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of District Driving, LLC, for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
