This matter is before the Commission on the request of respondent for an extension of time to comply with Order No. 16,855, served March 1, 2017, which assessed a civil forfeiture of \$10,750 against respondent for transporting passengers for hire between points in the Metropolitan District on 43 days while Certificate No. 2446 was suspended or revoked. In recognition of respondent's production of inculpatory records, the order suspended all but \$2,700 of the forfeiture conditioned upon payment within 30 days.

On March 31, 2017, respondent tendered a \$270 money order and seeks approval to pay the remainder of the forfeiture in nine equal monthly installments of \$270 each.

The Commission has approved payment plans in the past after acknowledging the carrier's "good faith" down payment.¹ Accordingly, the requested extension is hereby granted. Respondent shall pay the remaining \$2,430 in nine monthly installments of \$270 each. Each installment shall be due on the first day of the month beginning June 1, 2017.

Certificate No. 2446 shall be subject to revocation, and the full forfeiture of \$10,750 - minus payments received - shall become due and payable, upon respondent's failure to timely remit each installment payment.
