This matter is before the Commission on applicant's request for an extension of time to pay a \$1,000 civil forfeiture assessed in Commission Order No. 16,895, served March 21, 2017, conditionally granting Certificate of Authority No. 3010.

Issuance of Certificate No. 3010 was made contingent on applicant satisfying two sets of conditions. First, Order No. 16,895 directed applicant to submit certain documents and present its vehicles for inspection by Commission staff within the 180-day maximum permitted in Commission Regulation No. 66, or by September 18, 2017. Second, the order gave applicant 30 days, or until April 20, 2017, to pay a \$1,000 civil forfeiture. Applicant has filed a request for an extension of the April 20 payment deadline. This is applicant's first request for an extension in this proceeding.

Under Commission Rule No. 7-05, the deadline for complying with a conditional grant of authority may be extended by the Executive Director for good cause shown, but not beyond the limits prescribed in Commission Regulation No. 66.

For good cause shown, the deadline for paying the \$1,000 civil forfeiture assessed in Order No. 16,895 is hereby extended to September 18, 2017.¹
