Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 534 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1 million primary and \$4 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent terminated on July 1, 2017, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 534 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 17,074, served July 6, 2017.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on July 13, 2017, filed an acceptable \$4 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsement on July 6, 2017, and tendered a \$100 check on July 24, 2017. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted in accordance with Regulation No. 58-13, and this investigation is terminated.
