By application filed July 25, 2017, Swift Sedans LLC seeks voluntary termination of Certificate No. 2446. The Executive Director may approve an application for voluntary termination under Regulation No. 54-08, provided the applicant is in good standing with the Commission.¹ Inasmuch as no fees, reports, or civil forfeitures are currently due from applicant, and applicant therefore is in good standing, the application shall be granted.

Applicant must still pay the civil forfeiture assessed in Order No. 16,855, as modified by Order No. 16,969. If applicant fails to timely pay the remaining seven monthly payments of \$270 each, the full forfeiture of \$10,750, less amounts paid, will become due and payable.²

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 2446 is hereby terminated, effective this date.

2. That within 30 days from the date of this order applicant shall:

- a. remove from applicant's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
- b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
- c. surrender Certificate No. 2446 to the Commission.
