IN THE MATTER OF:

Application of LPA LOGISTICS, LLC, Case No. AP-2017-241 for a Certificate of Authority -- Irregular Route Operations

By email dated December 19, 2017, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to file a list stating the names and titles of applicant's officers, (e.g., managing member, president, vice-president, secretary), no later than January 2, 2018. The email cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application. Applicant has yet to file said list.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions. An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair determination of the application. Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of LPA Logistics, LLC, for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
