By email dated January 12, 2018, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority. The email instructed applicant to furnish a list of owners (with contact information) and directed applicant to designate an agent located inside the Metropolitan District for the purpose of receiving service of process. The email cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information on or before January 26, 2018, would result in delay or dismissal of the application. Applicant has yet to furnish the list of owners and has yet to designate an agent.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.<sup>1</sup> An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair determination of the application.<sup>2</sup> Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.<sup>3</sup>

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of AM Tours and Charters Inc. for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
