Certificate No. 2176 was revoked pursuant to Regulation No. 58-15(a), in Order No. 17,465, served February 22, 2018, for respondent's willful failure to pay a \$100 late fee under Regulation No. 67-03(c). On March 16, 2018, respondent filed a request to reinstate Certificate No. 2176.

Under Regulation No. 58-15(b), if a carrier's authority is revoked for failure to comply with Regulation No. 58, or an order issued thereunder, the Executive Director shall reopen the proceeding and reinstate said authority if the following two conditions are met: (i) the carrier files a timely application for reconsideration in accordance with Rule No. 27; and (ii) the application is supported by the necessary Endorsement(s) and by payment of the late fee under Regulation No. 67-03(c); provided, that reinstatement shall not be available if the carrier's WMATC operating authority stands revoked for other reasons, as well.

Respondent's request was filed within the 30-day deadline established for seeking reconsideration under Rule No. 27; the request is supported by the necessary Endorsement(s) and by payment of the late fee under Regulation No. 67-03(c); and Certificate No. 2176 does not stand revoked for any other reason.

Accordingly this proceeding is hereby reopened, and Certificate of Authority No. 2176 is hereby reinstated.
