By email dated May 10, 2018, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish additional information regarding applicant's control relationship with WMATC Carrier No. 1316, Gold City Transportation Inc. The email directed applicant to describe the relationship in detail and explain the anticipated effect on competition and employees if common control is approved. The email cautioned that failure to timely furnish the requested information would result in delay or dismissal of the application. Applicant submitted a statement regarding competition and employees but no statement describing the control relationship with Gold City.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.<sup>1</sup> An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair determination of the application.<sup>2</sup> Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.<sup>3</sup>

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Shalom General Transportation Inc. for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
