Case No. MP-2018-080

Certificate No. 2456 was automatically suspended on May 1, 2018, pursuant to Regulation Nos. 60-03 and 67-04 as a result of respondent's failure to file a 2018 annual report and pay a \$150 late fee incurred under Regulation No. 67-03(a) on or before April 30, 2018. Order No. 17,596, served May 1, 2018, in Case No. MP-2018-064 gave respondent 30 days in accordance with Regulation Nos. 60-04(a) and 67-06(a) to file the annual report and pay the \$150 late fee or face revocation of Certificate No. 2456. Respondent filed an acceptable annual report on June 4, 2018, but has yet to pay the \$150 late fee.

While Case No. MP-2018-064 was pending, Certificate No. 2456 was further suspended on May 7, 2018, by operation of Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), when the \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated without replacement. Order No. 17,607, served May 7, 2018, in Case No. MP-2018-080 gave respondent 30 days in accordance with Regulation No. 58-12(b) to file the necessary WMATC Endorsement(s) and pay the \$100 late insurance fee or face revocation of Certificate No. 2456. Respondent has yet to file an acceptable insurance endorsement and pay the \$100 late fee.

Accordingly, Certificate No. 2456 shall be revoked pursuant to Regulation Nos. 58-15(a) and 67-09(a).

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 2456 is hereby revoked.
2. That \$250 in unpaid late fees shall remain due in accordance with Regulation No. 67.

3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:

- a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
- b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
- c. surrender Certificate of Authority No. 2456 to the Commission.
