By email dated July 30, 2018, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish additional information no later than August 13, 2018. The email cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application. On August 13, 2018, applicant emailed the Commission and asked for a two week extension of time to furnish the requested information. On August 15, 2018, the Commission granted applicant's extension request by extending the deadline to August 27, 2018. Applicant has yet to respond.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair determination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Nationwide Chauffeured Services LLC for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
