Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 3006 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated at 12:01am on November 2, 2018, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 3006 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 17,897, served November 2, 2018.

Later in the day on November 2, 2018, respondent filed an acceptable \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement and respondent's insurance broker tendered a \$100 check on respondent's behalf. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted in accordance with Regulation No. 58-13, and this investigation is terminated.
