Certificate No. 3099 has been suspended under Regulation No. 58-12 since October 20, 2018, for respondent's willful failure to maintain compliance with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 17,877, served October 22, 2018, noted that Certificate No. 3099 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within 30 days. Respondent has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the late fee. Replacement endorsements filed November 8 are not acceptable because the address of the carrier does not match the address on file with the Commission as required by Regulation No. 58-04(b). Accordingly, Certificate No. 3099 shall be revoked pursuant to Regulation No. 58-15(a).

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. That Certificate of Authority No. 3099 is hereby revoked.
- 2. That the \$100 late insurance fee shall remain due in accordance with Regulation No. 67.
- 3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 3099 to the Commission.
