Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 2712 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1 million primary and \$3 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent terminated on May 15, 2019, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 2712 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 18,166, served May 15, 2019.

Respondent filed acceptable \$1 million primary and \$3 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on May 16, 2019, and tendered a \$100 check on May 20, 2019. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted in accordance with Regulation No. 58-13, and this investigation is terminated.
