Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 3015 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated at 12:01 a.m. on May 28, 2019, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 3015 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 18,186, served May 28, 2019.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement later the same day, and tendered a \$100 online credit card payment on May 31, 2019. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted in accordance with Regulation No. 58-13, and this investigation is terminated.
