Certificate No. 1229 was automatically suspended on May 1, 2019, pursuant to Regulation Nos. 60-03 and 67-04 as a result of respondent's failure to file a 2019 annual report, pay its \$175 annual fee for 2019, and pay \$300 in late fees incurred under Regulation No. 67-03(a), (b) on or before April 30, 2019. Order No. 18,144, served May 1, 2019, in Case No. MP-2019-045 noted that Certificate No. 1229 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the report and pay the fees within 30 days.

While Case No. MP-2019-045 was pending, Certificate No. 1229 was further suspended on May 22, 2019, by operation of Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), when the \$1 million primary and \$4 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent terminated without replacement. Order No. 18,177, served May 22, 2019, in Case No. MP-2019-082 gave respondent 30 days in accordance with Regulation No. 58-12(b) to file the necessary WMATC Endorsement(s) and pay the \$100 late insurance fee or face revocation of Certificate No. 1229.

On June 25, 2019, respondent filed an acceptable 2019 annual report and paid \$575 by check in satisfaction of its \$175 2019 annual fee, \$300 in late fees assessed under Regulation No. 67-03(a), (b), and \$100 late fee assessed under Regulation No. 67-03(c). Also on June 25, 2019, respondent filed an application requesting voluntary termination of Certificate No. 1229.

The Executive Director may approve an application for voluntary termination under Regulation No. 54-08, provided the applicant is in

good standing with the Commission.¹ Inasmuch as no fees or reports are currently due from Miljen Transportation, LLC, and Miljen Transportation, LLC, therefore is in good standing, the application shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1229 is hereby terminated, effective this date.

2. That within 30 days from the date of this order applicant shall:

- a. remove from applicant's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
- b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
- c. surrender Certificate No. 1229 to the Commission.
