Certificate No. 139 was revoked in Order No. 18,206, served June 4, 2019, for respondent's willful failure to file a 2019 annual report, pay a \$175 annual fee for 2019, and pay \$300 in late fees incurred under Regulation No. 67-03(a)&(b) on or before May 31, 2019. Respondent subsequently filed the report and paid the annual fee and late fees and has requested reinstatement of Certificate No. 139.

Under Regulation Nos. 60-05(b) and 67-09(b), if a carrier's authority is revoked for failure to comply with Regulation No. 60 and 67, or an order issued thereunder, the Executive Director shall reopen the proceeding and reinstate said authority if the following two conditions are met: (i) the carrier files a timely application for reconsideration in accordance with Rule No. 27; and (ii) the application is supported by the necessary complete annual report and by payment of all applicable fees under Regulation Nos. 67-02 and 67-03; provided, that reinstatement shall not be available if the carrier's WMATC operating authority stands revoked for other reasons, as well.

Respondent's request was filed within the 30-day deadline established for seeking reconsideration under Rule No. 27. The request is supported by the necessary 2019 annual report, annual fee for 2019, and late fees, and Certificate No. 139 does not stand revoked for any other reason.

Accordingly this proceeding is hereby reopened, and Certificate of Authority No. 139 is hereby reinstated.
