On October 1, 2019, Commission Regulation No. 58 required respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1632 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and to maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of such coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum. Certificate No. 1632 became automatically suspended on October 1, 2019, under Regulation No. 58-12 when the \$5 million primary WMATC Endorsement on file for respondent terminated without replacement.

Order No. 18,400, issued in this proceeding on October 1, 2019, noted the automatic suspension of Certificate No. 1632, directed respondent to cease transporting passengers for hire under Certificate No. 1632, and gave respondent 30 days to file the necessary WMATC Endorsement(s) and pay the \$100 late fee due under Regulation No. 67-03(c) or face revocation of Certificate No. 1632.

On August 20, 2019, the Commission issued Order No. 18,329 conditionally approving respondent's application to add a 15-person seating capacity restriction to Certificate No. 1632.<sup>1</sup> Adding the seating capacity restriction to Certificate No. 1632 confines respondent's operations to vehicles with a seating capacity of 15 persons or less, including the driver, and reduces to \$1.5 million respondent's minimum insurance obligation under Commission Regulation No. 58.

The conditions of approval in Order No. 18,329 included the requirement that respondent file one or more WMATC Endorsements showing \$1.5 million in coverage. The \$2 million WMATC Endorsement filed by respondent on October 3, 2019, with an effective date of September 30, 2019, satisfies that condition. Respondent has satisfied the other conditions of approval, as well, and Certificate

No. 1632 has been reissued this day as amended consistent with the terms of Order No. 18,329.

In addition, respondent has paid the \$100 late fee due under Regulation No. 67-03(c).

Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
