On November 25, 2019, Elite Medical Transit Professional L.L.C. filed an application requesting voluntary termination of Certificate No. 2956.

The Executive Director may approve an application for voluntary termination under Regulation No. 54-08(d). The application shall be denied if applicant is not in good standing with the Commission.<sup>1</sup>

Before a decision was rendered in the application proceeding, Certificate No. 2956 was automatically suspended on November 29, 2019, pursuant to Regulation No. 58-12 for the failure of Elite Medical Transit Professional L.L.C. to maintain on file with the Commission proof of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit, motor vehicle liability insurance as required by Commission Regulation No. 58.

Order No. 18,524, served November 29, 2019, noted that Certificate No. 2956 would be subject to revocation if Elite Medical Transit Professional L.L.C. failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the \$100 late fee due under Regulation No. 67-03(c) within 30 days. Elite Medical Transit Professional L.L.C. filed the necessary insurance endorsement(s) on December 2, 2019, but has yet to pay the late fee.

Because Elite Medical Transit Professional L.L.C. is not in good standing with the Commission, having failed to pay the \$100 late fee, the application for voluntary termination shall be denied.<sup>2</sup>

Because Elite Medical Transit Professional L.L.C. has failed to pay the \$100 late fee, Certificate No. 2956 shall be revoked pursuant Regulation No. 58-15(a). The unpaid \$100 late fee shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the application of Elite Medical Transit Professional L.L.C. for voluntary termination of Certificate No. 2956 is hereby denied.

2. That Certificate of Authority No. 2956 is hereby revoked.

3. That the \$100 late insurance fee shall remain due in accordance with Regulation No. 67.

4. That within 30 days from the date of this order Elite Medical Transit Professional L.L.C. shall:

- a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
- b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
- c. surrender Certificate No. 2956 to the Commission.
