By application filed June 11, 2020, Alamen LLC seeks voluntary termination of Certificate No. 3310. The Executive Director may approve an application for voluntary termination under Regulation No. 54-08(d). The application shall be denied if applicant is not in good standing with the Commission.<sup>1</sup>

Each carrier holding a WMATC certificate of authority on the first day of the calendar year must file an annual report and pay an annual fee on or before January 31 of that year.<sup>2</sup>

Applicant held Certificate No. 3310 on January 1 of this year but filed its 2020 annual report after the January 31 deadline and has yet to pay the \$175 annual fee for 2020, and now owes \$300 in associated late fees under Regulation No. 67-03. In addition, applicant was assessed a \$100 late insurance fee in Order No. 18,844, on May 21, 2020,<sup>3</sup> and has yet to pay that fee, as well. Consequently, applicant is not in good standing.

Until such time as applicant has complied with Regulation No. 67 by paying the \$175 annual fee for 2020 and paying \$400 in late fees, a request for voluntary termination of Certificate No. 3310 shall not be approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application of Alamen LLC for voluntary termination of Certificate No. 3310 is hereby denied without prejudice.
