Greyhound Airport Services, Inc., has filed proposed WMATC Tariff No. 10 amending the existing tariff as follows, to be effective January 10, 1970:

The special individual passenger rates now applicable to airline crews and diverted, scrip or cancelled flight passengers will no longer be available. Those passengers will be charged in accordance with the schedules now applicable to members of the general public. In addition, under the new tariff, charter rates will be increased and there will be no special charter rates for airline crews or airline passengers.

The Commission staff sent a copy of the proposed tariff to all airlines who are regular users of Greyhound Airport Transport's services at Washington National and Dulles and requested their views on it. In response, we received letters from the airlines management councils at both airports. Both councils objected to the increased rates and requested hearings. We will suspend Tariff No. 10 and set a hearing to consider the reasonableness of the rates proposed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That the proposed Greyhound Airport Services, Inc., WMATC Tariff No. 10 proposed to be effective on January 10, 1970 be, and it is hereby, suspended.

2. That a hearing to consider the proposed tariff be held on Tuesday, February 10, 1970, at the hearing room of the Commission, 1625 I Street, N. W., Room 314, Washington, D. C., at 10:00 a.m.

3. That Greyhound Airport Services, Inc., publish notice of this hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the Washington Metropolitan area, once, at least twenty-five days prior to said hearing.

4. That interested persons desiring to be heard on this matter shall so indicate to the Commission, with a copy to L. C. Major, Esquire, Suite 301, Tavern Square, 421 King Street, Alexandria, Virginia, 22314, counsel for Greyhound Airport Services, Inc., at least ten days prior to said hearing.
