On November 27, 1970, D. C. Transit System, Inc. (Transit) filed Application No. 663, seeking authority to combine and extend its Routes J-5, N-2, and N-4. Notice was posted in vehicles operating over the affected routes beginning on November 30, 1970. Several members of the public have written both to oppose the application and to suggest amendments to it.

We believe that sufficient interest has been shown to warrant a public hearing to enable us to receive more detailed testimony on the merits of this application. In setting a hearing date, however, we shall waive the normal requirement for 25 days notice before hearing as there has already been adequate public notice of the proposal, and we are aware that it would be administratively beneficial to Transit if a decision on this matter could be reached before January 24, 1971, the requested effective date of the application.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That a public hearing on this matter be held on Wednesday, January 6, 1971, at 10:00 A.M. in the hearing room of the Commission, Room 314, 1625 Eye Street, N. W., Washington, D. C.

2. That D. C. Transit System, Inc. post notice of the time and place of the above hearing on all buses operating over the affected routes.

3. That D. C. Transit System, Inc. publish notice of the above hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District once, not less than 10 days prior to January 6, 1971.
