

By Formal Complaint filed with this Commission, Alexandria, Barcroft and Washington Transit Company (A. B. & W.) alleged that WMA Transit Company (WMA) was submitting bids to conduct certain operations, and was conducting certain operations, in excess of the operating authority conferred in its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity. On June 7, 1973, we issued our Order No. 1258 which revoked the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity theretofore held by WMA. Accordingly, this proceeding is now moot.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint filed by Alexandria, Barcroft and Washington Transit Company herein be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
