By letter-petition, filed May 13, 1975, counsel for The Colonial Transit Company, Inc. (Colonial) requests Commission approval of the withdrawal of Application No. 863, dated May 2, 1975. By that application, Colonial seeks a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate motor vehicles for the transportation of passengers over irregular routes pursuant to a contract with Reston Commuter Bus, Inc., between Reston, Virginia, and Washington, D. C. The application awaits official action by the Commission.

Colonial also requests to have the Commission consider its Application No. 861, Docket No. 287, for authority to perform charter operations pursuant to contract with Reston Commuter Bus, Inc. That application currently is scheduled for public hearing to commence Thursday, June 5, 1975. See Order No. 1422, served April 22, 1975.

The request to withdraw Application No. 863 shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the petition by counsel for The Colonial Transit Company, Inc., to withdraw Application No. 863, dated May 2, 1975, be, and it is hereby, granted.
2. That Application No. 863, dated May 2, 1975, be, and it is hereby, dismissed without prejudice.
