By Order No. 1889, served September 28, 1978, the Commission granted temporary authority in the above-captioned case subject to certain conditions. That order, inter alia, required applicant within 10 days to file an appropriate tariff and certificate of insurance and an affidavit of compliance with Commission Regulation No. 68 concerning identification of vehicles. On October 4, 1978, a certificate of insurance<sup>\*/</sup> was filed.

On October 6, 1978, American University, by its Assistant Treasurer, filed a request for an extension of time until October 20, 1978, to file its tariff and affidavit concerning vehicle identification. Additionally, the request indicates the University needs the time to formalize certain revisions in its transportation program which are under consideration.

Applicant's request will be approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant's request for an extension of time, filed October 4, 1978, is hereby approved.

2. That applicant is hereby directed to file, not later than October 30, 1978, (a) two copies of its WMATC Temporary Authority Tariff No. 1, in accordance with Commission Regulation 55, and (b) an affidavit that each of its vehicles to be used in the proposed service is identified in accordance with Commission Regulation 68.



<sup>\*/</sup> The certificate of insurance was in accord with the requirements of Commission Regulation No. 62, as amended, but expires January 1, 1979. Order No. 1889 conditionally grants temporary authority through February 28, 1979, and applicant is reminded that this certificate of insurance must be timely replaced for applicant's temporary authority to remain in force.

3. That the temporary authority granted by Order No. 1889 shall become effective upon acceptance by the Executive Director of the above-required filings and shall remain in effect through February 28, 1979, unless otherwise ordered.

4. That in all other particulars, the requirements of Order No. 1889 continue in full effect.
