By email dated August 14, 2020, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish additional information no later than October 5, 2020.¹ The email cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application. Applicant has yet to furnish the requested information, including a current certificate of good standing.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.² An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair determination of the application.³ Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.⁴

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of One United Group Transportation Service LLC for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
