By email dated March 20, 2020 pursuant to Regulation No. 54-04(b), applicant was directed to furnish additional information necessary to a full and fair determination of this application. The additional information was due no later than October 13, 2020.<sup>1</sup> The email cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application. Applicant has yet to furnish the requested information, including a signed list stating the names and titles of applicant's officers.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.<sup>2</sup> An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair determination of the application.<sup>3</sup> Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.<sup>4</sup>

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Veestan Logistics LLC for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
