Case No. MP-2020-165

Certificate No. 1053 was automatically suspended on August 1, 2020, pursuant to Regulation Nos. 60-03 and 67-04 as a result of respondent's failure to file a 2020 annual report, pay its \$175 annual fee for 2020, and pay \$300 in late fees incurred under Regulation No. 67-03(a), (b) on or before July 31, 2020.<sup>1</sup> Order No. 18,923, served August 3, 2020, in Case No. MP-2020-131, noted that Certificate No. 1053 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the report and pay the fees within 30 days. Respondent did not respond.

While Case No. MP-2020-131 was pending, Certificate No. 1053 was further suspended on August 27, 2020, by operation of Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), when the \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated without replacement. Order No. 18,977, served August 27, 2020, in Case No. MP-2020-165 gave respondent 30 days in accordance with Regulation No. 58-12(b) to file the necessary WMATC Endorsement(s) and pay the \$100 late insurance fee or face revocation of Certificate No. 1053. Respondent has yet to file an acceptable insurance endorsement and pay the \$100 late fee.

Accordingly, Certificate No. 1053 shall be revoked pursuant to Regulation Nos. 58-15(a), 60-05(a), and 67-09(a).

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1053 is hereby revoked.

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<sup>1</sup> This year, the date when a carrier's operating authority was suspended for failure to file a 2020 annual report, failure to pay a 2020 annual fee, or pay associated late fees, was extended from May 1, 2020, to August 1, 2020. See *Partial Waiver of Rules of Practice and Procedure and Regulations, Regulation Nos. 60-03, 67-01, and 67-04*, Gen. Order No. 24 (Apr. 27, 2020).

2. That respondent's 2020 annual report and \$575 in outstanding fees shall remain due in accordance with Regulation Nos. 60 and 67.

3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:

- a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
- b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
- c. surrender Certificate No. 1053 to the Commission.
