Case No. MP-2020-147

Certificate No. 3103 has been suspended under Regulation No. 58-12 since March 24, 2020, for respondent's willful failure to maintain compliance with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 18,733, served March 24, 2020, noted that Certificate No. 3103 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within 30 days. Respondent did not respond.

In the meantime, Certificate No. 3103 was further suspended on August 1, 2020, pursuant to Regulation Nos. 60-03 and 67-04 as a result of respondent's failure to file a 2020 annual report and pay a \$150 late fee incurred under Regulation No. 67-03(a) on or before July 31, 2020.¹ Order No. 18,923, served August 3, 2020, in Case No. MP-2020-147, noted that Certificate No. 3103 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the report and pay the late fee within 30 days. Respondent did not respond.

Accordingly, Certificate No. 3103 shall be revoked pursuant to Regulation Nos. 58-15(a), 60-05(a), and 67-09(a).

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 3103 is hereby revoked.
2. That respondent's 2020 annual report and \$250 in outstanding fees shall remain due in accordance with Regulation Nos. 60 and 67.

¹ This year, the date when a carrier's operating authority was suspended for failure to file a 2020 annual report, failure to pay a 2020 annual fee, or pay associated late fees, was extended from May 1, 2020, to August 1, 2020. See *In re Partial Waiver of Rules of Practice and Procedure and Regulations, Regulation Nos. 60-03, 67-01, and 67-04*, Gen. Order No. 24 (Apr. 27, 2020).

3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:

- a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
- b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
- c. surrender Certificate No. 3103 to the Commission.
